

On completion of the program you will be issued with a certificate confirming your status as Certified Installer or Certified Integrator. You will be eligible to request support from a Molex Connected Enterprise Solutions RCDD-accredited engineer, who will be able to assist with design, installation and testing of systems as required. They will also help you prepare the documentation needed to register any installations for an extended warranty.


Tools include a Consultant Proposal Generator, Cable Fill Rate Estimator, PoE Calculator and Permanent Link Calculator.


